HOW ARE THE CLASSES CONDUCTED?

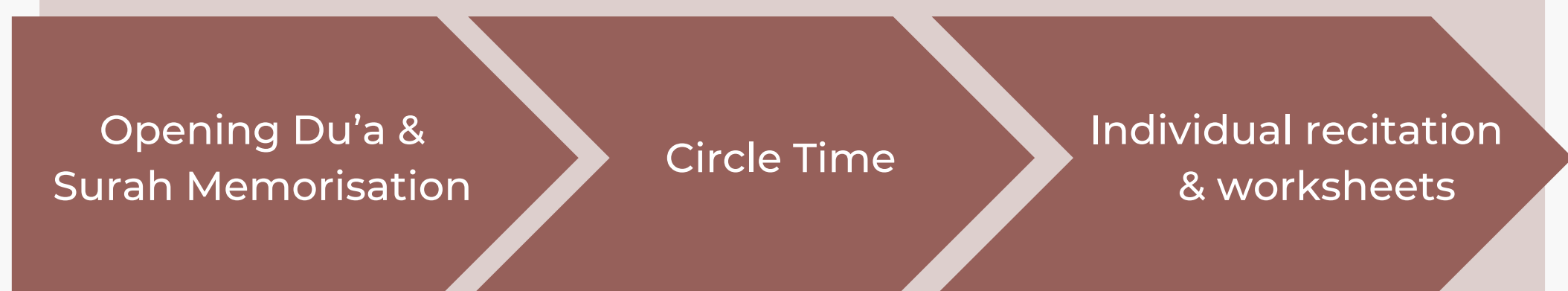
Every class will begin with Du'a and Surah memorisation.

Subsequently, during Circle Time, students are introduced to the Surah and its meaning through translation and fun activities. Students are also taught to write basic Quranic letters as well as Tajwid.

Afterwards, teachers have individual students read with them, while their peers complete their assigned worksheets.

Each student will be equipped to read fluently and memorise the Surah assigned to them.

IS FARDHU AIN IN THE SYLLABUS?

At TPA, our focus is on providing holistic Quranic knowledge for our students. Thereafter, Fardhu Ain knowledge is not taught at TPA.



DOES MY CHILD NEED TO HAVE BASIC QURANIC / IQRA' KNOWLEDGE?

No, they do not. The teachers in TPA will assess each student's capabilities and teach Iqra' according to his / her level.



HOW MANY TEACHERS WILL BE TEACHING MY CHILD?

In an ideal situation where the attendance of every class has hit the maximum quota, there'll be 3 teachers in Tadiqu, and 2 teachers in Asas 1, 2 and Lanjutan.

For Tadiqu, the ratio of teacher to students is 1:7 whereas for Asas 1, 2 and Lanjutan, the ratio of teacher to students is 1:10 during individual recitation.

This arrangement ensures that teachers have sufficient time to work with every child on his / her Iqra' / Quranic reading.



IS TPA PART OF THE MOSQUE'S TAHFIZ PROGRAMME?

TPA is not part of the Tahfiz program.

TPA equips children with holistic Quranic knowledge including reading, writing, Tajwid and memorisation of Surahs, but does not focus on memorisation of the entire Quran, like a Tahfiz programme.

We recommend that your child enrol into the Tahfiz programme after completing TPA. Your child will be required to undergo the Tahfiz Entrance Test in order to be admitted to the Tahfiz programme.

He / She would be expected to be able to read the Quran, which is where TPA comes in: to provide the essential knowledge, and more.



WHAT'S NEXT AFTER TPA?

Once students in Lanjutan have completed their year and fulfill 1 or more criteria(s) below:

- Above 12 years old
- Pass Lanjutan examinations
- Able to recite the Quran

They will receive a Certificate of Completion & a letter suggesting classes which they can advance to

- Klinik Al-Quran
- Sijil Tahfiz
- Asas / Sijil Tajwid Al-Quran
